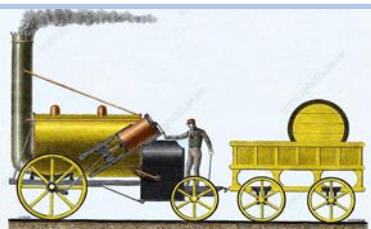

1829 - George Stephenson from Newcastle in England invents 'The Rocket'. It could travel at 35mph. No-one had ever travelled that fast before. 1885 – Karl Benz from Germany builds the first motor car, the Benz Motorwagon 1903 – The Wright brothers from America made their first successful aeroplane flight in 'The Wright Flyer.' 1908 - Henry Ford from America designs the Model T and began building lots of them in his factory.
