Nursery - Animals (Spring 1)

Vocabulary	Word definition
Polar animals	The animals include the reindeer, polar bear, Arctic fox, narwhal, walrus, seal, ox, moose, orca, and snowy owl. The Alaskan malamute is a powerful sled dog from Alaska. This small, white fox lives farther north than any other land animal.
Jungle animals	A jungle is a forest thick with trees, other plants, and animals. ... Jungles — thick tropical forests — are full of life: birds, insects, reptiles, monkeys, and often gorillas and other animals. They're dangerous places, even for the animals that live there. This is why jungle also means any place that is risky or wild.
Oceanic/sea animals	Sea creature - any of numerous animals inhabiting the sea including e.g. fishes and molluscs and many mammals.
Pets	A pet, or companion animal, is an animal kept for a person's company,
Habitat	A habitat is a place that an animal lives. It provides the animal with food, water and shelter.
Insects	Insects are small animals with four or more legs and a hard outer shell called an exoskeleton. Most have wings and antennae
