What is Printing?

Printing is making a copy of objects E.g. HAND, FOOT or leaves.



Printing can be used to produce all kinds of images or pictures.

Choosing a type of printing is important EG: sponge printing can be used to produce pictures of flowers, buildings and landscapes.

Using pattern when printing is a useful technique

E.G a repeated pattern of a print can be used to build up a skyline or a row of houses.

How to make a handprint
