Printing - A print is a copy of another piece of art or object. Art prints can be printed using different printing methods and can be produced on a variety of different materials.

Printing can be used to produce all kinds of images or pictures.

Choosing a type of printing is important EG: sponge printing can be used to produce pictures of flowers, buildings and landscapes.

Using pattern when printing is a useful technique

EG: a repeated pattern of a print can be used to build up a skyline or a row of houses.

Lino printing is a type of printing-What is it?

Lino Printing is a printmaking technique. In lino printing a design is cut into the lino surface with a sharp knife. The lino is then inked with a roller then pressed on a piece of paper or fabric.
