

Year 2- Comparing localities (Small area of UK and small area in a contrasting non- European country)

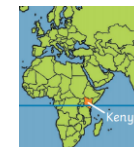
Vocabulary	Word definition
Africa	A continent south of Europe and between the Atlantic and Indian oceans
village	A small town or community often in the country
mountain	An area of land with great height and steep sides. It is higher than a hill
hill	A raised area of land smaller than a mountain
Culture	A pattern of behavior shared by a society, or group of people. Many different things make up a society's culture . These things include food, language, clothing, tools, music, arts, customs, beliefs, and religion.
Climate	The average weather conditions of a place over a period of years
Physical features	Physical geography is the study of the Earth's natural features, such as mountains, rivers, deserts and oceans. In physical geography, landforms and how they change are studied, as well as climate and its effects
Human features	A place made from human ideas and actions (a bridge, a town centre etc)
Population	The whole number of people living in a country, city, or area. A group of people or animals living in a certain place.
Equator	An imaginary circle around Earth. It divides Earth into two equal parts: the Northern Hemisphere and the Southern Hemisphere. It runs east and west halfway between the North and South poles.

Where is Kenya?

Kenya is one of the countries that make up the continent of Africa.

Kenya is a country in East Africa and is on the equator.

Kenya borders five countries (Somalia, Ethiopia, South Sudan, Uganda and Tanzania) and the Indian Ocean.



Fact: Kenya is officially known as the Republic of Kenya and the currency is Kenyan Shillings.

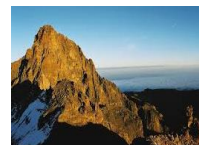
