## Vocabulary

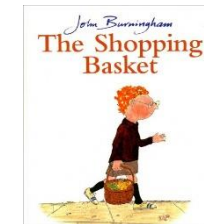
Vocabulary	Word definition
Shopping	To go to a place and buy more than one thing
Supermarket	A large shop where lots of things can be purchased, such as clothes, food and toys
food	A variety of things we eat, things we can buy in the shops or supermarket
clothes	Items that we wear, such as jeans, shoes and tops
till	The place at the end of the shopping trip where you pay for you items using money or card
receipt	A paper list to record what you have bought at the shops
Assistant	A person who will help you when shopping at the supermarket
money	Coins and notes we use to pay for the items you have bought at the supermarket
list	Writing, sometimes with numbers, to show what you need to buy from the supermarket
Basket	A small place to put the items you wish to buy from the supermarket
Trolley	A larger place to put things you want to buy from the supermarket, this is on wheels and you can push it around
