Vocabulary	Word definition
King	A male head of the royal family who rules the country for life
Monarch	The head of government also known as king, queen, emperor or empress
Parliament	A group of people who make laws for a country.
Civil War	A war that occurs between people who come from the same country
Traitor	A person who is not loyal or true to a friend or to the country they are from. A person who betrays their country
Treason	When a person acts against their country (For example might help another country fight a war)
Similarities	Having the same qualities- a likeness to something
Differences	What makes two or more persons or things not the same
