Vocabulary	Word definition
Bible	The Christians Holy Book.
Old Testament	The first part of the Christian Bible comprising of 39 books.
New Testament	The second part of the Christian Bible, It includes the 4 Gospels. Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.
Holy	Dedicated or consecrated to God or a religious purpose, sacred. 'Holy Bible'
Gospel	The record of Christ's life and teaching in the first four books of the new testament.
Word of God	The sacred writings of the Christian religions.
Mary Jones	Mary Jones was a Welsh girl who at the age of 15 walked 26 miles barefoot to buy a copy of the Welsh Bible because she did not have one.
Dead Sea Scrolls	Jewish religious manuscripts found in the Qumran Caves in the Judean Desert.




Good News	The story of Jesus Christ's birth, death and resurrection.
Elizabeth	The cousin of Mary, [Jesus' mother]
Zechariah	The husband of Elizabeth.
Jesus	The son of God.
Mary	The mother of Jesus
Angel Gabriel	The angel who appeared to Mary to tell her she was going to have a baby and name him Jesus.
Joseph	The father of Jesus
Shepherds	The shepherds were the first to be told of the birth of Jesus.
Bethlehem	The city is the birthplace of our Saviour Jesus Christ.
Incarnation	God in human form. Christians believe this to be Jesus

Gospels	The first four books of the Christian Bible. Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.
Trust	To rely on someone or something.
Faith	To have complete trust in someone or something.



## Religious Education - Year 2 - Why is the Church a special place for Christians? (Summer 1)

Vocabulary	Word definition
Church	A Building used for public Christian worship.
Vicar	A religious person who is a member of the clergy, who delivers the service in a Christian church.
Minister	A member of the clergy.
Pews	A long bench with a back, placed in rows in the main part of the churches to seat the congregation.
Font	A structure found in church that holds the water used during the Christening service.
Altar	The table in a Christian church at which the bread and wine are blessed in communion services.
Stained Glass	Coloured glass used to form decorative designs, usually found in churches.
Worship	A feeling or expression of adoration of someone or something.
Holy	Dedicated to God or a religious purpose; sacred. 'The Holy Bible'.
Sacred	Connected with God or dedicated to a religious purpose.

## Religious Education Year 2 What do Muslims believe? (Summer 2)

Vocabulary	Word definition
Mosque	A Muslim place of worship.
Allah	The Arabic word for God.
Pillars of Islam	Basic acts in Islam, which are the foundation of Muslim life.
Shahadah	The Muslim profession of faith.
Salah	Ritual form of prayer performed 5 times each day.
Sawm	Fasting, which begins at dawn and ends at sunset. No food or drink can be taken during the hours of fasting.
Zakat	Payment to support/benefit the poor and needy.
Hajj	The pilgrimage Muslims make to Mecca.
Quran	The Islamic sacred text.
Dome	A roof structure in the shape of half of a sphere on a mosque.
Minaret Tower	A tower from which the faithful are called to prayer five times each day by a muezzin, or crier.
Imam	A Muslim leader.


