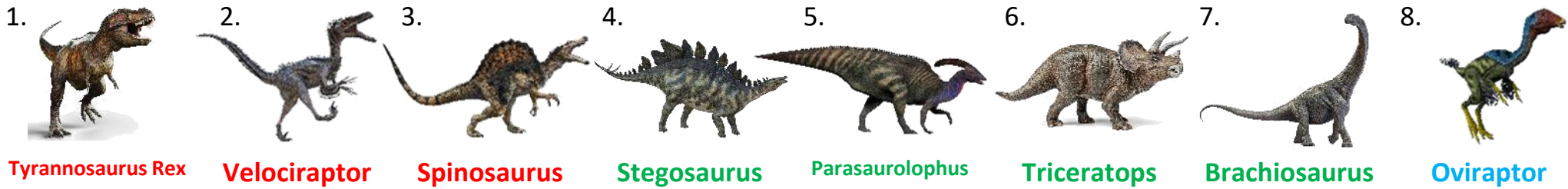

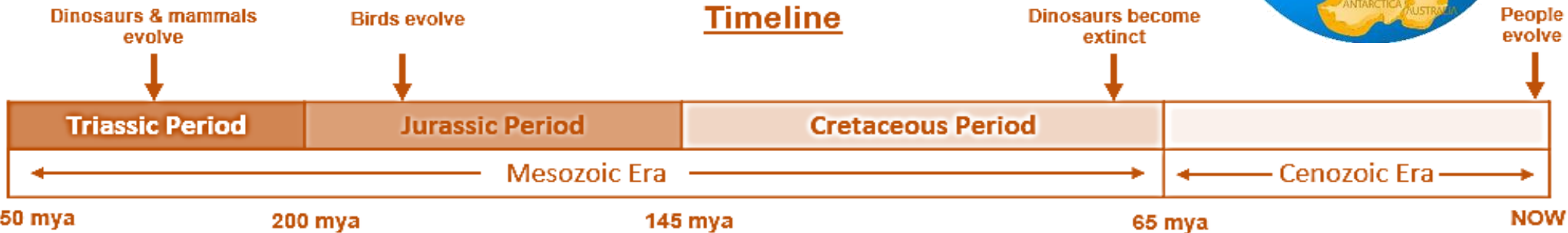


VOCABULARY

Carnivore	An animal that feeds on other animals.
Herbivore	A animal that feeds on plants.
Omnivore	An animal that feeds on both plants and animals.
Fossil	The remains, or mark, of a very old plant or animal, left in a rock.
Dinosaur	A group of reptiles which lived on earth for over 160 million years, long ago.
Mammal	A warm blooded animal which has hair or fur, and gives birth to live babies.
Extinct	A kind of animal that used to be alive, but now all of them are dead.
Palaeontologist	A scientist who studies fossils of animals and plants.
Pangaea	All of the land used to be joined together in one supercontinent, called Pangaea.
Reptile	A cold-blooded animal with scales, which lays eggs.
