What Is Printing? Printing is the process of copying the pattern of an object like a leaf that can be transferred onto other surfaces. It can be used to make one or more identical images or to create repeating patterns on papers and textiles.

Printing can be used to produce all kinds of images or pictures.

Choosing a type of printing is important EG: sponge printing can be used to produce pictures of flowers, buildings and landscapes.

Using pattern when printing is a useful technique

E.G a repeated pattern of a print can be used to build up a skyline or a row of houses.

How to make a printed leaf picture:

1. Collect a variety of leaves
2. Using colourful paint, carefully paint the surface of one leaf
3. Place the leaf paint side down onto your paper
4. Press firmly (careful not to smudge your paint)
5. Remove the leaf to reveal your leaf print
6. Repeat this using different colours and leaves to fill your paper
7. Leave your print picture to dry
