Vocabulary	Word definition
Autumn	The time of year between September and November. Many leaves fall off the trees.
Spring	The time of year between March and May. Lots of signs of new growth in Spring.
Summer	The hottest season in the UK. The time of year between June and August.
Winter	The coldest season in the UK. The time of year between December and February.
Weather symbol	These are signs used to help us understand more about our daily weather.
Temperature	Hotness or coldness can be measured using a thermometer
Season	The seasons are four different times during the year with different types of weather.

3. What season do lots of trees lose their leaves in?
