Vocabulary	Word Definition
World Wide Web	The part of the Internet that contains <b>websites</b> and webpages.
Internet	A network, or system, that connects millions of computers worldwide. This can be accessed through technology such as laptops, computers, phones, iPads, etc.
Network	A <b>network</b> consists of two or more computers that are linked in order to share resources (such as printers and CDs), exchange files, or allow electronic communications. The computers on a <b>network</b> may be linked through cables, telephone lines, radio waves, satellites.
Digital systems	<b>Digital systems</b> are designed to store, process, and communicate information in <b>digital</b> form. The <b>digital</b> computer, more commonly called the computer, is an example of a typical <b>digital system</b> .
Copyright	Refers to the legal right of the owner of intellectual property. In <b>simpler</b> terms, <b>copyright</b> is the right to copy. This means that the original creators of products and anyone they give authorization to are the only ones with the exclusive right to reproduce the work.
