Vocabulary	Word Definition
Database	A collection of data organised in a way that it can easily be retrieved e.g. bar chart, graphs.
Database field	A database field is a single piece of information from a record.
Record	Records in a database or spreadsheet are usually called "rows". A record is a collection of fields, possibly of different data types, typically in a fixed number and sequence.
Refine	To make minor changes to improve or clarify your data.
