
### Gunta Stölzl

### **alternate**

When you alternate two things, you keep using one then the other.

### **batik**

Batik is a process for printing designs on cloth. Wax is put on those areas of the cloth that you do not want to be coloured by dye.

### **bold**

A bold colour or pattern is very bright and noticeable.

### **decorations**

Decorations are features that are added to something in order to make it look more attractive.

### **fabric**

Fabric is cloth or other material produced by weaving together cotton, nylon, wool, silk, or other threads.

### **gold leaf**

Gold leaf is gold that has been beaten flat into very thin sheets and is used for decoration.

### **loom**

A loom is a machine that is used for weaving thread into cloth.

### **size**

The size of something is how big or small it is.

### **textiles**

Textiles are types of cloth or fabric, especially ones that have been woven.

### **wax resist**

Wax resist is a painting technique using wax to create a design and painting over this with a coloured wash.

### **weaving**

If you weave cloth or a carpet, you make it by crossing threads over and under each other.
