

<p><b><u>Helen Frankenthaler (1928-2011)</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Frankenthaler was a painter and printmaker.</li> <li>She was an abstract painter because she lived and worked in New York at a time when most of the exciting artists were making abstracts.</li> <li>She was influenced by the work of Jackson Pollock.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>John Singer Sargent (1856-1925)</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Singer Sargent painted a lot of full length portraits.</li> <li>He was famous for showing people with interesting expressions on their faces.</li> <li>Both of his parents were talented artists. His parents encouraged him to sketch.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>Ansel Adams (1902-1984)</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>He is famous for his incredible images of the West of America, including Yosemite National Park in California.</li> <li>He is also famous for making photography an important art form. Red, blue, and green are colours.</p> <p><b>conservation</b> Conservation is saving and protecting the environment.</p> <p><b>enormous</b> Something that is enormous is extremely large in size or amount.</p> <p><b>landscape</b> The landscape is everything you can see when you look across an area of land, including hills, rivers, buildings, trees, and plants.</p> <p><b>oil painting</b> An oil painting is a picture which has been painted using oil paints.</p> <p><b>photographer</b> A photographer is someone who takes photographs as a job or hobby.</p> <p><b>portrait</b> A portrait is a painting, drawing, or photograph of a particular person.</p> <p><b>Yosemite</b> Yosemite National Park is in California's Sierra Nevada mountains.</p>
