Vocabulary	Word definition
Synagogue	A building in which Jews meet for religious worship.
Rabbi	A person appointed as a Jewish religious teacher.
Shabbat	The day of rest for the Jewish people
The Torah	The Jewish holy text.
Mezuzah	A parchment inscribed with religious texts and attached to the doorpost of a Jewish house as a sign of faith.
Kippah	A skullcap worn by Orthodox male Jews.
Tallit	A fringed shawl worn during prayer by Jews.
Menorah	A sacred candle holder with eight branches used in Jewish worship.
