Vocabulary	Word definition
Bible	The Christians Holy Book.
Old Testament	The first part of the Christian Bible comprising of 39 books.
New Testament	The second part of the Christian Bible, It includes the 4 Gospels. Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.
Holy	Dedicated or consecrated to God or a religious purpose, sacred. 'Holy Bible'
Gospel	The record of Christ's life and teaching in the first four books of the new testament.
Word of God	The sacred writings of the Christian religions.
Mary Jones	Mary Jones was a Welsh girl who at the age of 15 walked 26 miles barefoot to buy a copy of the Welsh Bible because she did not have one.
Dead Sea Scrolls	Jewish religious manuscripts found in the Qumran Caves in the Judean Desert.

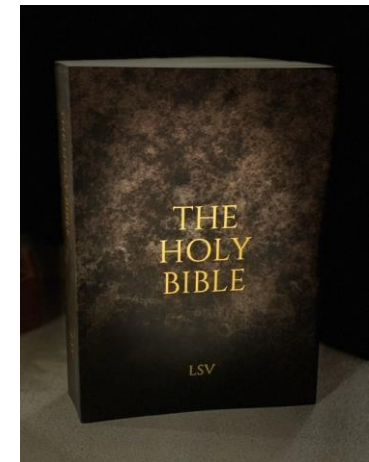
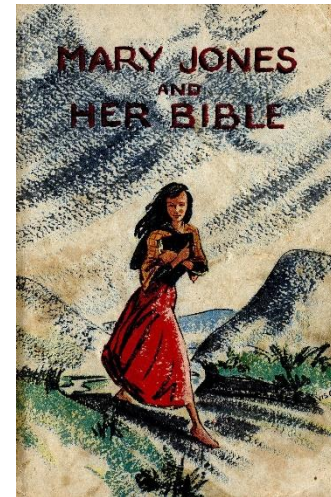

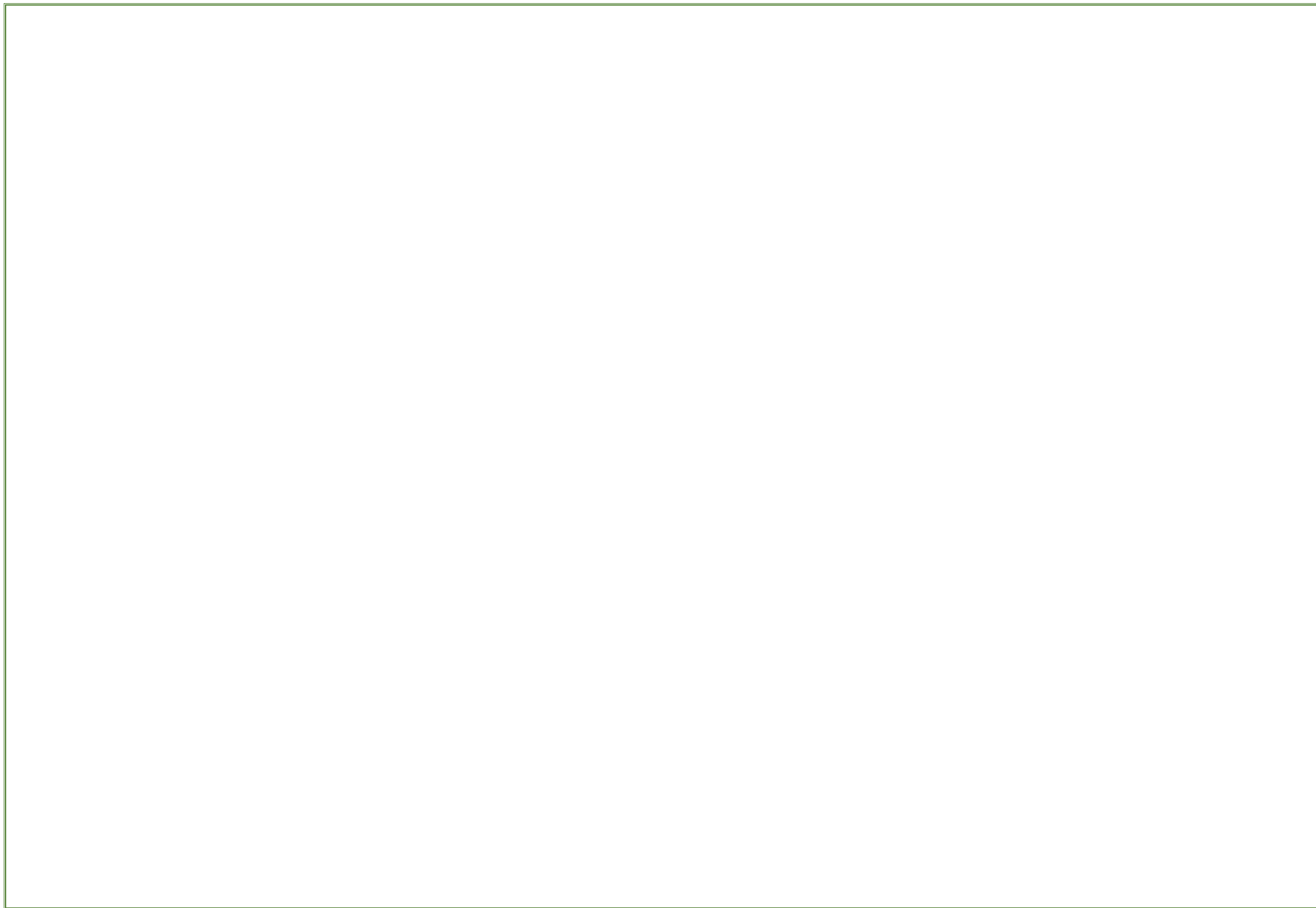
