Vocabulary	Word definition
Church	A Building used for public Christian worship.
Vicar	A religious person who is a member of the clergy, who delivers the service in a Christian church.
Minister	A member of the clergy.
Pews	A long bench with a back, placed in rows in the main part of the churches to seat the congregation.
Font	A structure found in church that holds the water used during the Christening service.
Altar	The table in a Christian church at which the bread and wine are blessed in communion services.
Stained Glass	Coloured glass used to form decorative designs, usually found in churches.
Worship	A feeling or expression of adoration of someone or something.
Holy	Dedicated to God or a religious purpose; sacred. 'The Holy Bible'.
Sacred	Connected with God or dedicated to a religious purpose.

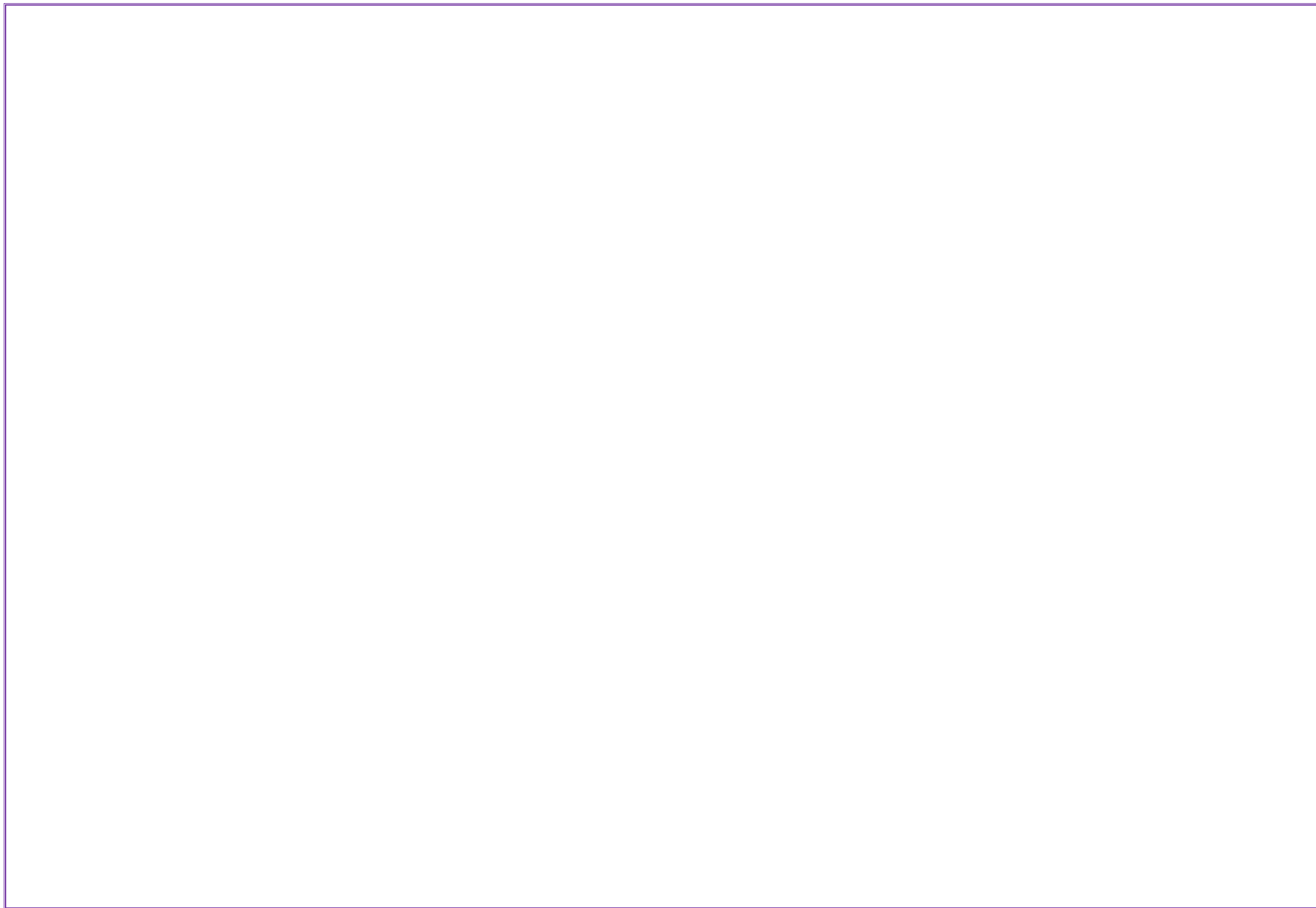
