Vocabulary	Word definition
Mosque	A Muslim place of worship.
Allah	The Arabic word for God.
Pillars of Islam	Basic acts in Islam, which are the foundation of Muslim life.
Shahadah	The Muslim profession of faith.
Salah	Ritual form of prayer performed 5 times each day.
Sawm	Fasting, which begins at dawn and ends at sunset. No food or drink can be taken during the hours of fasting.
Zakat	Payment to support/benefit the poor and needy.
Hajj	The pilgrimage Muslims make to Mecca.
Quran	The Islamic sacred text.
Dome	A roof structure in the shape of half of a sphere on a mosque.
Minaret Tower	A tower from which the faithful are called to prayer five times each day by a muezzin, or crier.
Imam	A Muslim leader.

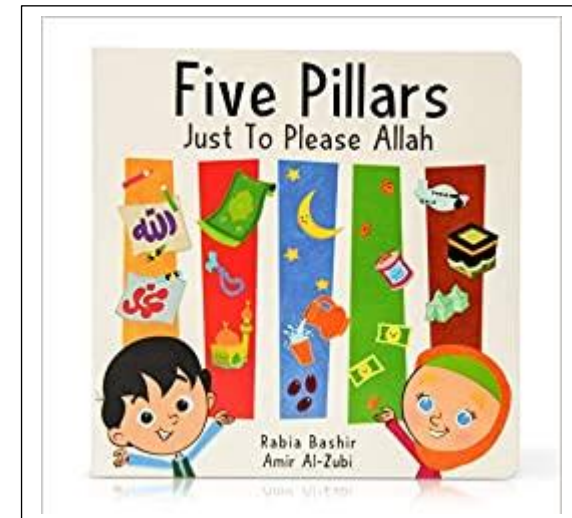

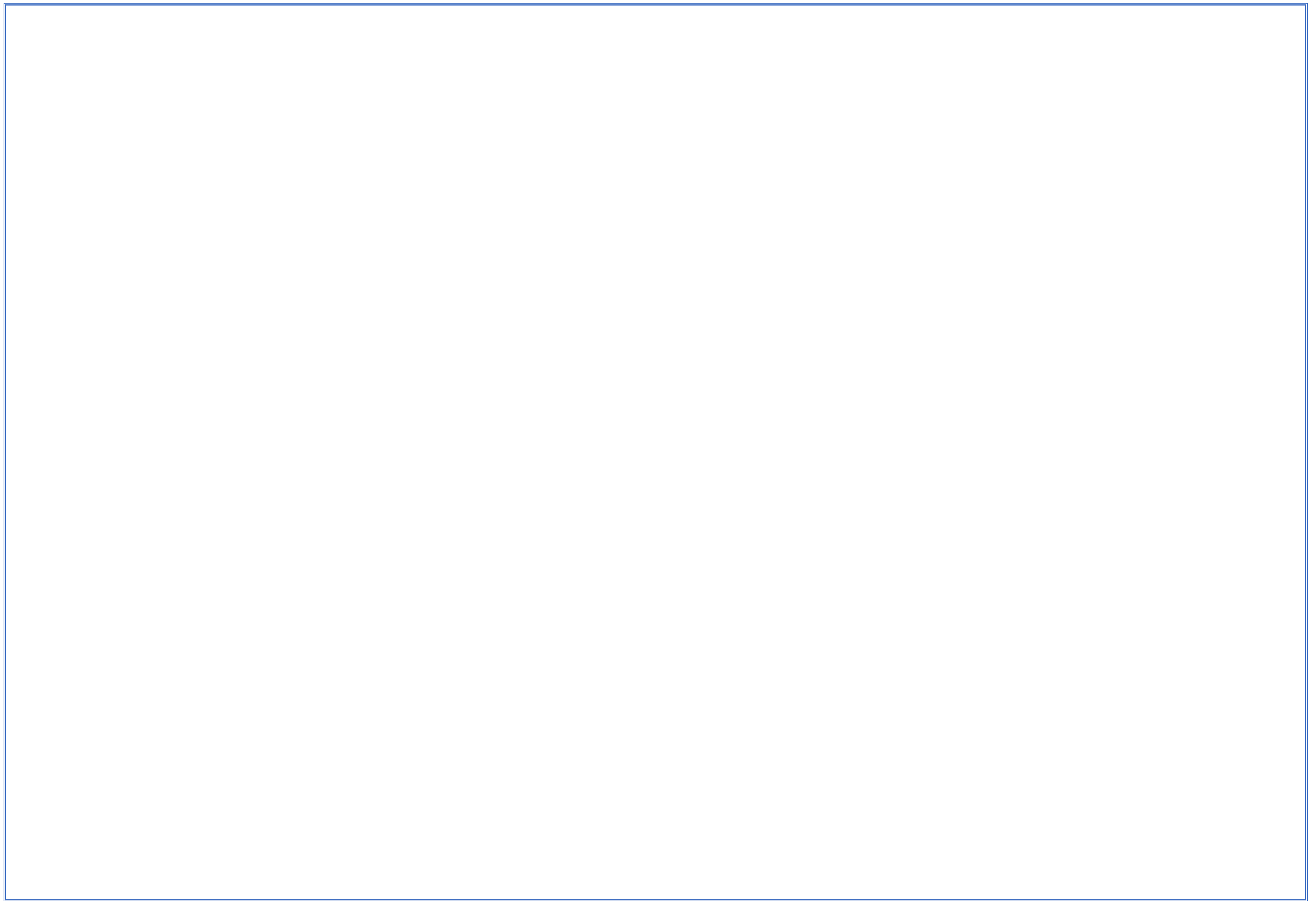
