Key Knowledge

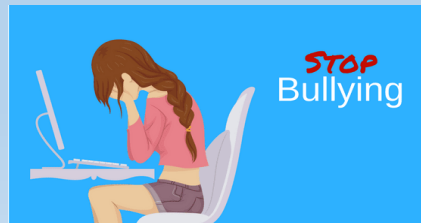
- I know what culture means.

Key Vocabulary

Artefacts	A cultural objects made by someone.
Bullying	Regular hitting or frightening someone who is seen as weaker.
Culture	The ideas, customs and social behaviour of a particular people or society
Cyber bullying	The use of electronic communication to bully a person usually sending threatening nature.
Discrimination	The unjust treatment of different categories of people especially on the grounds of race, age, sex or disability.
Developing world	Countries where most of its people live on a lot less money and have fewer public services.
Homophobic	Having or showing a dislike or prejudice against gay people.
Race	A category of people that share certain distinctive physical traits.
Racism	The belief that certain characteristics so as to distinguish them as inferior or superior to another.
Rumour	A circulating story or report that may not be true.
